Oskar Lehmann founded the company in 1961 in order to manufacture injection moulding machines himself. The production of in-house plastic parts was initially a side business.

The surprisingly high demand from the furniture industry led to the company switching its focus to the production of plastic parts.

With its 187 employees, Oskar Lehmann GmbH & Co. KG is today the leading plastic supplier to the furniture industry with a primary focus on office and property furniture. On 98 machines, the company produces various technical plastic products on a 3-shift basis. Alongside the classic injection moulding technology, the company also utilises special processes (2K-technology, metal overmoulding, GID). In order to do so, the company utilises injection moulding tools that are developed and built in the in-house Tool Construction Department. Metallisation, printing, painting and a comprehensive assembly service rounds off the range of services offered by the company. The market-oriented logistics enable the company to quickly and flexibly react to the market requirements.

The company has registered 18 patents and 36 registered designs. Close cooperations with the Ostwestfalen-Lippe University of Applied Sciences, the University of Kassel, Hanover IfBB – Institute for Bioplastics and Biocomposites and the WBA Tooling Academy Aachen ensure technical exchanges of expertise and joint research projects.
